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49 **OLD BUSINESS** 50 51 2) Bid Award – Umatilla Water Plant Upgrades 52 53 City Manager Irby said project bids came in higher than the legislative appropriation and said value engineering would take out some of the components specified in the contract. Staff has asked for a two 54 55 year extension to the project time line. 56 57 Discussion ensued on the length of time the apparent low bid would be good and possible funding 58 through a Community Development Block Grant application. 59 60 Engineer Ted Wicks discussed the positive aspects of installing new high service pumps and other 61 components which will enhance the current water plant. The available funding would allow us to do the majority of the project less the ground storage tank. 62 63 64 Council consensus was for staff to contact the state and request a modification to the contract scope. 65 66 MOTION by Tarby; SECOND by Kent; to table the proposal on the bid award and ask Mrs. Howard to please make a phone call as soon as possible and report at the next meeting on January 67 68 20, 2015. Motion carried. 69 70 3) CCNA – RFQ 2014-C Recommendation of Engineering Firm for Water Line Improvement 71 **Project** 72 73 City Manager Irby stated at the last meeting he was directed to negotiate with BESH. I talked to BESH and determined best step would be to figure out a scope and plan. The engineering fee of \$22,135 would 74 75 be covered under the state appropriation. Staff recommends you award the planning to BESH. 76 77 **Duane Booth** of BESH believed a two-step process is the best approach in identifying the highest 78 priorities. A huge part of the cost is surveying and locating utilities. Our company did the Water Master 79 Plan six years ago. We can pull that and new information together and give you very specific pricing and 80 put the lines in the most economical place possible. 81 82 MOTION by Tarby; SECOND by Adams; to approve BESH to do the scope and plan for \$23,135. Motion carried. 83 84 85 **President Olson** noted there would be a brief reception honoring Mr. Cadwell and Mr. Adams. 86 87
