ISSUE: Setting Final Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2020-2021

BACKGROUND SUMMARY: The City of Umatilla's Final Millage for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 was set at 7.1089 during the Special meeting held on July 29, 2020. Under Florida Statute, if a local government does not adopt the roll-back rate, the government is required to advertise a Notice of Proposed Tax Increase.

The roll-back rate calculates taxable property values which generate the same total revenue as in the previous year. The roll-back rate this year is 6.9317.

The TRIM notices mailed to property owners reflected both the millage rate of 7.1089 and the Final Fire Assessment.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS: Adopt Resolution 2020 – 21 setting the Final Millage Rate of the City of Umatilla for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 at 7.1089 which is more than the rolled-back rate of 6.9317 by 2.56%.

FISCAL IMPACTS: Millage rate of 7.1089 generates \$1,143,762 which is \$141,972 more than last year's property taxes.
