# **JOB CHARACTERISTICS**

Performs skilled maintenance and construction work requiring laboring knowledge in the water or wastewater fields acquired through training or work experience as a Utility Worker I. This position also involves operating and maintaining heavy equipment. Routine tasks are performed with considerable independence and more difficult work is performed under direct supervision.

# **EXAMPLES OF MACHINES, TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT USED**

Hand tools such as shovels, rakes, hammers, saws, pipe wrenches, etc.; power tools such as chain saws, lawn mowers, power saws, sewer cleaning machine, tapping machines, jack hammers, small equipment such as sprayers, air compressors, trenching machine, etc.; large equipment such as tractors, dump trucks, backhoe, front end loader, sewer cleaning truck, well point equipment, pneumatic boring tools and utility televising equipment

## **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

#### Water Department

- Maintain and repair water, sewer pipes and reclaimed water pipes;
- Installs fire hydrants, water meters, meter boxes and fittings;
- Cleans sewer lines:
- Locates water, sewer and reclaimed water mains;
- Installs valves and conduits;
- Operates pumps and generators;
- Performs inspection and maintenance on equipment and vehicles;
- Lays sod;
- Performs maintenance and custodial tasks such as sweeping, cleaning, removing refuse, painting, etc.;
- Assists the City in the preparation for and aftermath of a major emergency, such as a hurricane or other storm or disaster
- Performs basic utility inspections, under the direction of the supervisor;
- Performs concrete work;
- Assists operator with plant maintenance such as lubricating motors and equipment, replacing packing in pumps and valves;
- Installs sprinkler systems and makes repairs;
- Assists with the training of Utility Worker I;
- Performs other related duties as required.

## Wastewater Department

- Operates equipment including tractors, dump trucks, loaders, etc.;
- Trains subordinates;
- Completes and maintains various forms, logs and records;
- Performs maintenance around shop and stock room including sweeping, cleaning, removing refuse and paper;
- Performs inspections and maintenance on equipment and vehicles;
- Installs underground water and sewer lines
- When assigned, assists the Lift Station Mechanic or Lead Operator in the following duties: conducts preventive maintenance on lift stations;
- Maintenance and minor repairs on lift stations such as lubricating motors and equipment, replacing packing in pumps and valves;
- Operates pumps, valves, motors, controls and switches;
- Installs new equipment;
- Cleans and installs pipes and pipe-fittings;
- Assists with the training of Utility Worker I;
- · Performs other related duties as required.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

<u>Knowledge</u>, <u>Abilities and Skills</u> - Knowledge of the operational characteristics of assigned equipment, tools, materials; knowledge of equipment maintenance and repair; knowledge of safe driving techniques and related occupational hazards

Ability to carry out assignments with minimum instructions; ability to adhere to prescribed routines and practices; ability to read and write and perform math calculations with speed and accuracy; ability to detect improper functioning of mechanical systems and make minor adjustments; ability to drive and operate assigned equipment; ability to work on call rotation, and if require nights, weekends and holidays;

<u>Physical Demands</u> - This is heavy physical work most of the working time. Requires frequent walking; frequent standing, climbing, stooping, reaching, bending, lifting 50+ pounds, carrying/pushing/pulling 50+ pounds; good finger/hand dexterity and hand/eye coordination; good eyesight; hearing and speech or vocal communication (for safety); working in adverse environmental conditions (heat, cold, rain, etc.) for long periods of time; regular driving and operation of assigned equipment.

Minimum Qualifications - High School Diploma or recognized equivalent; minimum of two (2) years public utilities experience preferably as Utilities Tech I within the utility department. A demonstrated ability to read and write is a prerequisite for employment in this position; a class "C" Water Distribution License issued by the State of Florida or Class "C" Water Operator Certification issued by the State of Florida; Valid Florida Driver's License required; Class C Wastewater Collection Certificate from FWPCOA or Class "C" Waste Water Operators Certification issued by the State of Florida, Back-flow Certification desirable or the ability to obtain if required. Maintaining necessary CEU' is also required
