

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for PWS 3351402 Umatilla Water Works

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the August 2023 we monitored for disinfectant byproducts instead of in July 2023 and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

Some people who drink water containing trihalomethanes in excess of the MCL over many years may experience problems with their liver, kidneys, or central nervous system, and may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

Some people who drink water containing haloacetic acids in excess of the MCL over many years may have an increased risk of getting cancer.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

What happened? What is being done?

Stage 2 Disinfection Byproducts were pulled in August 2023 instead of July 2023 due to Operator oversight. We have since taken the samples, August 29th 2023 and the results came back that we are within the standards regulated by FDEP.
